

Chief Report for 5/24

- We have responded to 0 EMS 1 Fire Calls (service call)
- Total Calls YTD 16 EMS & 8 Fire related calls
- 0 capital expenses 0 Disposals
- Insurance for the crew has been issued. I hope to be in the slip at Co-Op by the end of the month or the beginning of next. Unfortunately the cost is 12,500 and our deductible is extreme. This is due to having multiple claims over the last couple years. The premium has been paid. We had 3 companies refuse to insure us.
- FEMA- our contact has been changed to another representative who is very helpful. We will be taken care of and Austin states he will be available for whatever we may need. Been unable to get the invoices for the island clean up the money that UCCA paid out. I was hopeful to get some reimbursement for UCCA.
- Annual Audit has started Duncan has been extremely helpful as he has provided the needed centennial bank statements. The Backup of our QuickBooks has been sent. All the invoices have been pulled and are ready to scan and uploaded into Smartsheet which is the program from the auditor. As I stated last month I would need help making this audit as seamless as possible. The treasurer Mike Filipczac stated he would assist in the audit. Unfortunately he is out of town until 6/20 the Audit is due no later than the 30th of June. With that being the issue I would like to see if anyone else is available to help. I only ask because as I stated last month no other chief is required to do this as this is a financial and/or a logistics responsibility. Obviously this falls on the chief if the audit has issues.
- I spoke to Mark, our ISO representative. If we lose an engine we lose 3 points on the ISO. I do not know what that entails in the big scheme of things. I know water will always be an issue for us on a large structure fire. I know the CET pump is not functional as is. E192 is at best a water shuttle; we can not rely on this engine for structural fire fighting. A new engine estimate is 325K-350K. The repairs on E192 I believe wouldn't be prudent. Purchasing the Hale pump would be a step in the right direction.

I have not prepared a true analysis because I have no idea what the repairs would cost. As it would need to be barged off and thoroughly investigated. We can have a discussion on this.

- I received a quote on garage doors and openers. 2 of our openers are from the original install and they no longer make parts for them. I will see who else may provide a bid to our beautiful island. All our doors are ready to be replaced per the technician. We currently have 1 opener not working. I believe with the repairs happening after the board picks a contractor we should look into the bay doors and openers as well.
- I asked Van to please put on the agenda budget clarification. My idea on a budgetary line item: if the board states I have 10K on a particular line item then I have the leeway to make the necessary purchases or repairs within that allotted amount. Asking the board for approval at every meeting for a repair or purchase if it's already been approved. If I should exceed the line item for any reason I would need to explain why this has happened. Obviously I know I have the leeway to spend up to 5K without approval. I would like to have a discussion on this for clarification.
- I have planned on meeting with Noah safety harbor manager about our septic and water. He is investigating the tiers that are offered to members and where we stand.
- As summer rolls in we will have a lot of visitors who enjoy our waters. I believe we would be well suited to get a small personal watercraft. I have priced out jet skis with the help from a few others who have knowledge of them. It would allow us to do near shore rescues with a single person operating the vessel. We would put together a SOG/SOP and those who are qualified to operate the jet ski would be assigned to the vessel for the day. We will also have a paddle board available for launch from the beach. We can get a very nice used jet ski for less than 5K.
