## What is a Fire Chaplain?

#### Ministry of Presence

- Provides spiritual and other support to those in the fire service and those affected by emergency crisis
- Specific role in each department is determined by an agreement (SOG) with the Fire Chief
- Non-denominational and nonsectarian, ministering equally to people of all faith traditions or those with no faith tradition at all
- Father Mulcahy from M\*A\*S\*H

# What Initiated the Program?

#### Significant Events

- 2019 drowning events
- Panama Shell house fire
- > Unique Needs
  - No easy access for victim/patient families to facilities
  - Many people are visitors from out of town
  - Fire support arriving are without vehicles and knowledge of island
  - Rotating Firefighter resources creates less "island" knowledge

### **Focus Areas**

- Care to the Chief and Deputy Chiefs
- > Care to Firefighters
- Care to Those Affected by Emergency Crisis
- Logistical/Practical Support to Firefighters

## **Continuous Improvement**

- Learning
  - Self Study, Formal Certification
- Planning and Preparation
  - Plan, Practice, Review and Adjust
- > Practice
  - Station visits, responding to 911 calls, serving islanders and visitors
- Mentor/Accountability Partner
  - Chaplain Mark Goodman
- Connection to Peers
  - Weekly Fire Chaplain Zoom call

## **Experiences Since 2021**

#### Frequent Sit-Downs with Chief

- Sounding board, listening ear
- Debrief on incidents
- Relay public perceptions
- > 911 Response Support
  - Several medical calls
  - Fire suppression support
  - Logistics support on scene
- Community Care Support
  - Death scene support
  - Patient family support/logistics
