RESOLUTION #2020-003

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE UPPER CAPTIVA FIRE PROTECTION AND RESCUE SERVICE DISTRICT, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO RECOGNIZE THAT YEAR 1 (FISCAL YEAR 2014-15) SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS ARE NO LONGER A CURRENT ASSET FOR FINANCIAL STATEMENT PRESENTATION; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Upper Captiva Fire Protection and Rescue Service District of Lee County, Florida. "the District", previously adopted a Fire Services Non-Ad Valorem Special Assessment (the "Assessment") for no more than 10 years, against all qualified real property within the "Assessment Area" (which is coterminous with North Captiva Island, Lee County, Florida) and which was approved on July 8, 2014 in a referendum of the qualified electors pursuant to Resolutions No. 14-01 and 14-03; and

WHEREAS, due to the timing of adopting the first year of the Assessment, Fiscal Year 2014-15, billing invoices had to be done by the District rather than by using the Uniform Method of Collection offered by the Tax Collector and which since has been utilized in subsequent years; and

WHEREAS, as of March 31, 2020, after multiple billings, there remains ten (10) properties which have not paid the Year 1 (Fiscal Year 2014-15) Assessment totaling \$7,181.63, the amount of which is over five (5) years outstanding on the District's financial statements; and

WHEREAS, the definition of a Current Asset for financial statement presentation is "cash and other assets that are expected to be converted to cash within one (1) year"; and

WHEREAS, for financial statement presentation only, it is recommended that \$7,181.63 be recognized as uncollectible within one (1) year and removed as a current asset from the District's financial statements; and

WHEREAS, all liens associated with the Year 1 assessment on these properties will remain and when the property is transferred, sold or otherwise makes the lien collectible, such Year 1 assessment collection will be recognized as a revenue of the then-current fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE UPPER CAPTIVA FIRE PROTECTION AND RESCUE SERVICE DISTRICT THAT:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS. The recitals set forth are true and correct and form a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY. The Board of Commissioners of the Upper Captiva Fire Protection and Rescue Service District is authorized to adopt this Resolution by Florida law.
