

March Chief Report

- Emergency calls YTD-23 Fire-8 EMS-15 with 20 Public Service Responses.
- T192- Back in service replaced rusted plumbing and pump is running great.
- B191- The alternator that was replaced after the August fire apparently was not operating properly. There seems to be an issue with these units burning through alternators to mitigate that we may need to install a 12-volt inverter per the shop doing work. We are having the other alternator refurbished, so we have an extra one on hand always.
- Crew boat prop I being refurbished at Burris prop repair. We also have a coil pack that is failing so it is being addressed.
- Kubota tractor has been delivered to island we utilized Shoreline for barging service. I have set up a training session with Creel Tractor sales representative Christy to teach any firefighter who would like to learn how to operate properly. I will

extend this offer to capable island residents if they want to attend in the off chance, we need assistance getting it to a fire scene.

- Restructure of district titles to follow ICS along with promotions. This will allow duties to be better delegated.
